


Getting Started with Core Knowledge for Lawyers

In our course, we will not spend a lot of time reviewing the reading assignments. Instead, you'll get right to work applying the concepts you read about. For that to work, you need to understand the main concepts from your textbook. Core Knowledge for Lawyers (CKL) will help you do that.

Like Core Grammar for Lawyers, CKL is a self-directed, subscription-based, online learning tool. It will help reinforce important concepts that you read about in *The Complete Legal Writer*, which in turn will prepare you to engage in class activities.

Registering for Core Knowledge for Lawyers

1. A new copy of *The Complete Legal Writer* comes with a single-use access code that gives you a one-year subscription to the online exercises. The code is on a card that is tucked into the middle pages of the textbook.



2. To register for CKL, go to <http://coreknowledgeforlawyers.com>. Then, click the green, "Register for CKL" button.

3. Next, fill in your information. Keep a record of which email address you use and your password.



3. You'll see a "Registration Pending" screen and a prompt to check your email for an "Activation Email" from CKL.

4. The email will give you a link to activate your account. Click on the link, which will take you to a welcome screen and a prompt to click a "Welcome to CKL" book image. Click the image.



5. You'll see a screen with a link to "Launch" a chapter called "Getting Started with CKL." Click "Launch."

6. Read the welcome screen and click "continue" when you're done. The remaining screens give you instructions about how to add more practice sets and use your access code to join your professor's class.





The **rhetorical triangle** is a three-part approach to analyzing documents and writing them effectively. The three points of the triangle are (1) audience, (2) purpose, and (3) persona. All three points work closely together. They help you categorize your observations about a genre or a document. Categorizing helps you identify ways to improve your writing.
